



## WEBINAR: Introduction to LEED

Thursday, May 14, 2009; 12:00-1:15pm Eastern

**PRESENTER:** Michael A. Kaweck, LEED AP, GA of *Axiom Sustainable Consulting, LLC*

**DESCRIPTION:** LEED provides a complete framework for assessing building performance and meeting sustainability goals. LEED emphasizes state of the art strategies for sustainable site development, water savings, energy efficiency, materials selection and indoor environmental quality. LEED recognizes achievements and promotes expertise in green building through a comprehensive system offering project certification, professional accreditation, training and practical resources. This overview presentation discusses the different LEED products and samples some of the more common strategies and credits of the LEED system.

**LEARNING OBJECTIVES:**

- Gain an understanding of the industry trends that have led to sustainability, and the background of USGBC and the LEED rating system
- Gain an understanding of the different LEED products available, and identify the appropriate product to utilize for different buildings
- Gain an understanding of various LEED credits, and how to apply them

Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions of the presenter. Upon receipt of your registration form, a confirmation email will be sent that will include pre-testing instructions to eliminate last-minute technical issues. Two days before the program date, you will receive another email with the connection instructions, including a link for downloading the various program materials in advance.

**CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS:** After the program, upon receipt of your *Attendance Sign-In Sheet*, a group Certificate of Completion will be emailed to you. Architects, Engineers, and other professionals may be able to earn 1.25 continuing education credits for their participation in this program as follows:

**ARCHITECTS:** PLAN is a registered provider with the AIA Continuing Education System (AIA/CES). This 1.25 hour program offers 1.25 LU hours/HSW/SD, which will be reported directly to the AIA/CES for AIA members. For individual states' licensing boards, it is the Architect's responsibility to determine whether this activity meets the various guidelines set forth by those state boards where he/she registered.

**ENGINEERS:** PLAN's webinar partner, Contract Solutions Group (CSG) is a national provider of continuing education to design professionals, and is an approved provider in the 3 states that require pre-approval of providers offering PE credits: **Florida, New York and North Carolina.** Florida engineers must score 70% or greater on a 10-question post-program quiz in order to earn 1.25 PDH credits. For **all other states** with Mandatory Continuing Education Requirements in place, it is the Engineer's responsibility to determine whether this activity meets the requirements set forth by his/her state licensing board. We can advise that most of those states have adopted the following subject matter criteria in awarding credits: "A course or activity whose purpose and objective are clear with a content that will maintain, improve or expand the skills and knowledge of the licensee's field of practice".
